## • Teacher's Day Celebration:


It was a college level activity. Cultural activities and Street play were organized by NSS volunteers for teachers. 79 volunteers participated in the celebration.






#### NSS Day:








#### • Bhajan Sandhya - Gandhi Jayanti:


## • Children's Day Celebration:
