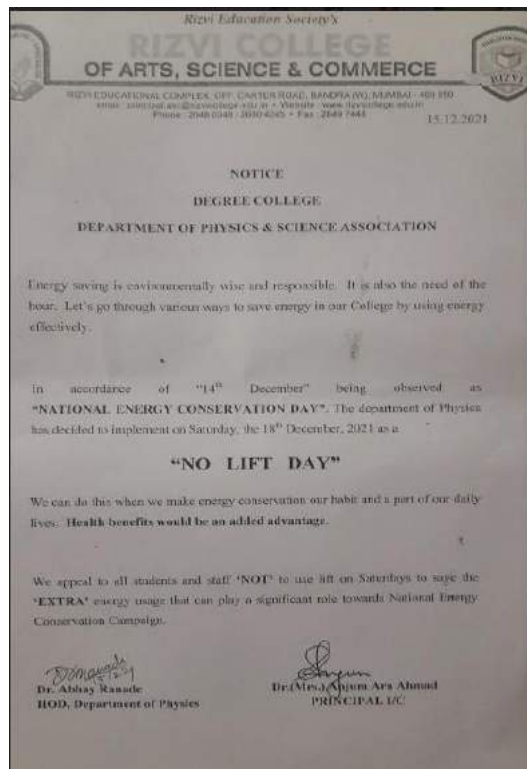
- **HIV/AIDS Awareness:**

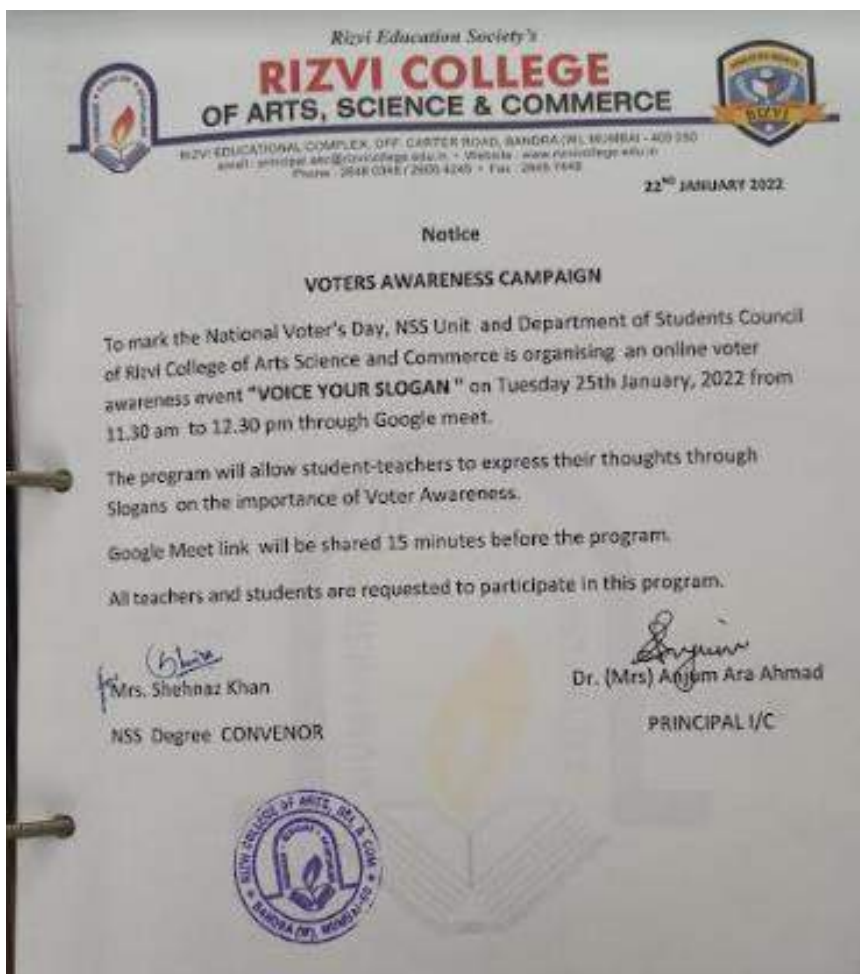

- **National Voter's Day:**

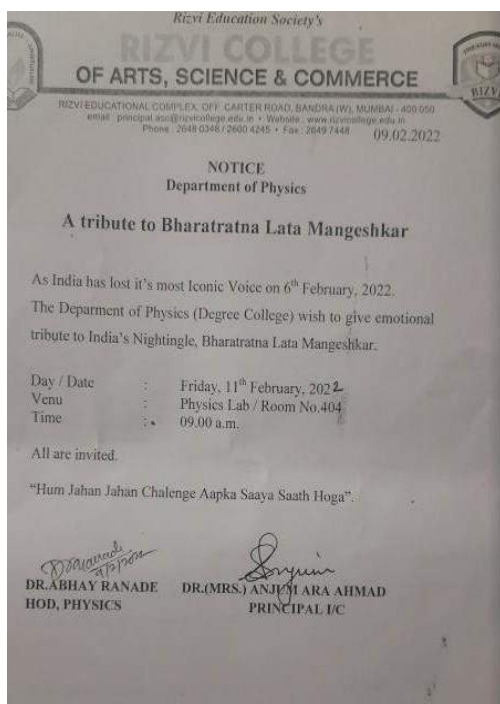

- **Republic Day:** It was a College level Activity.15 volunteers and Programme officers participated in the flag hosting ceremony in the college campus on 26th January 2022.

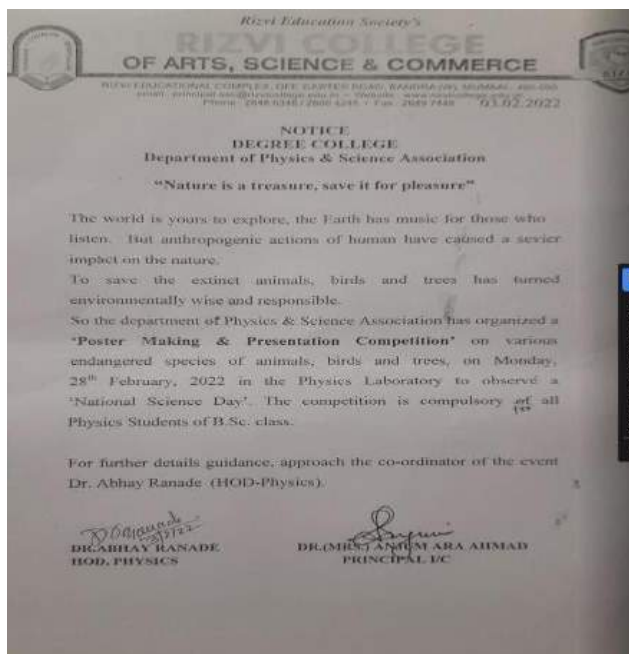
