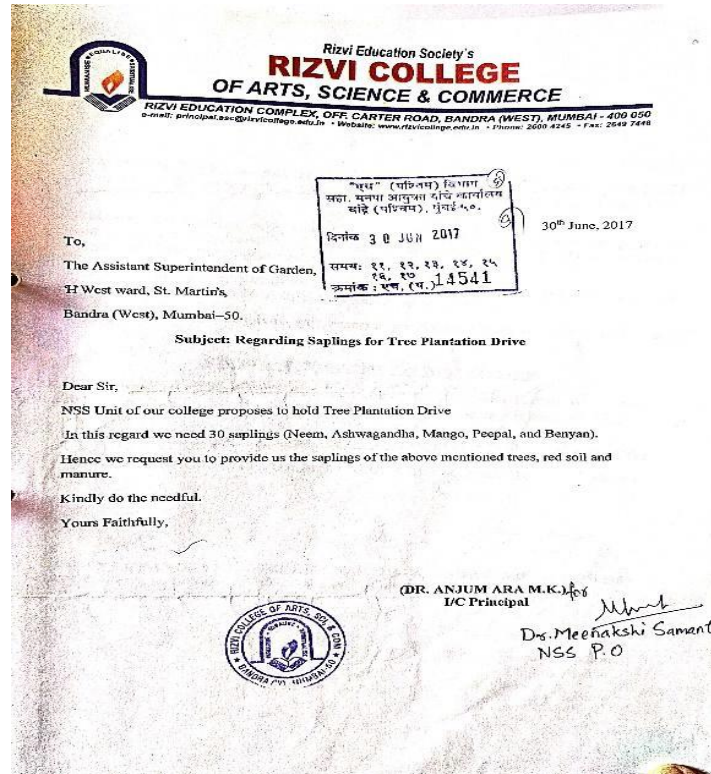

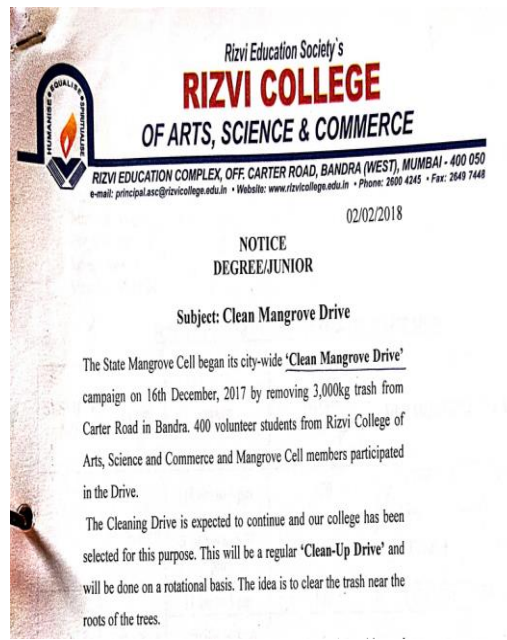


- Through the NSS following activities were conducted to promote social awareness

Session wise duty has been allotted to Departments and Faculties and they are required to conduct the activity along with the students of respective classes allotted to them.

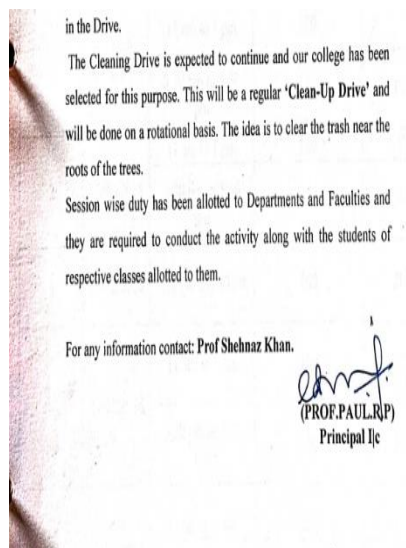
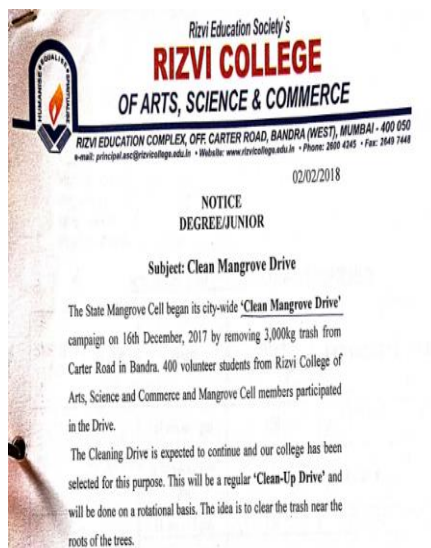
