On 16 September the department of Physics (Degree College) and Science Association has organized TWO ACTIVITIES as follows,

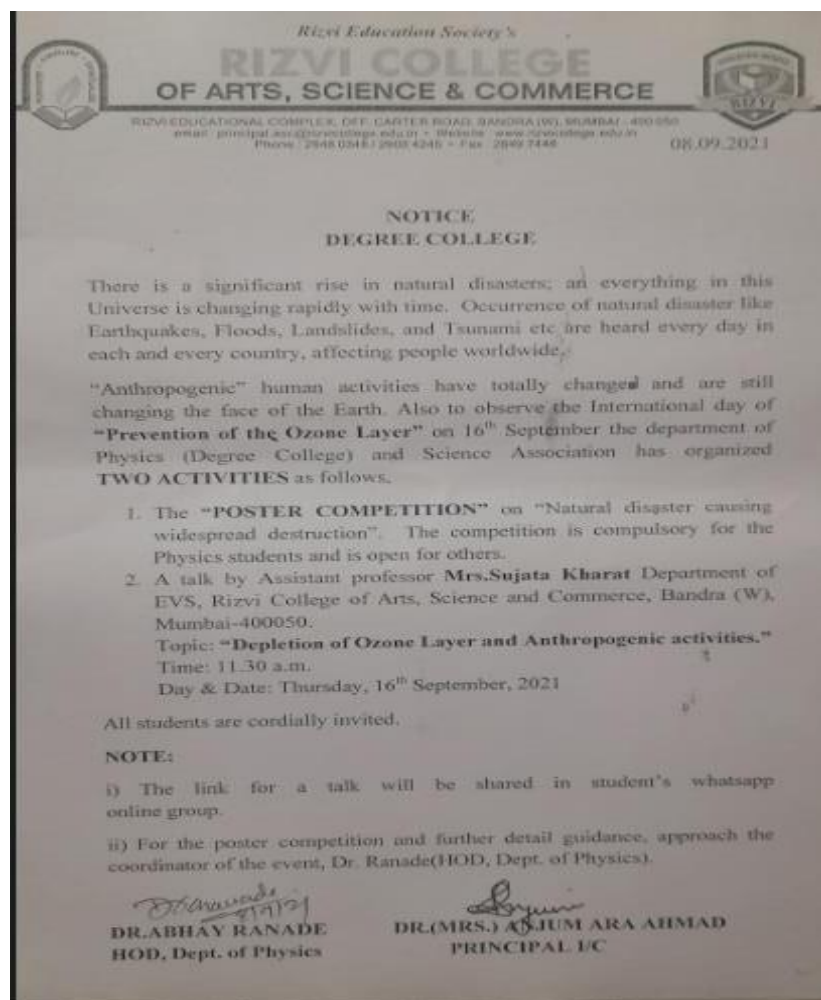
1. The "POSTER COMPETITION" on "Natural disaster causing widespread destruction". The competition is compulsory for the Physics students and is open for others.

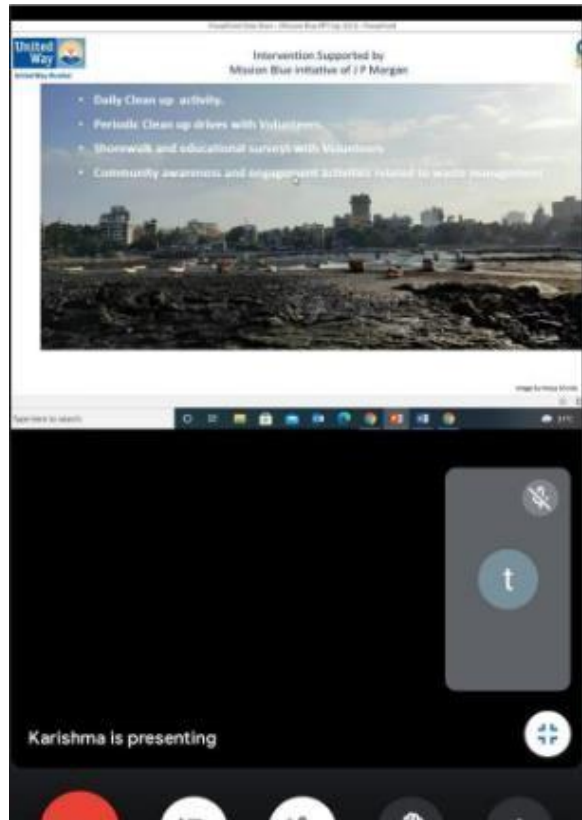

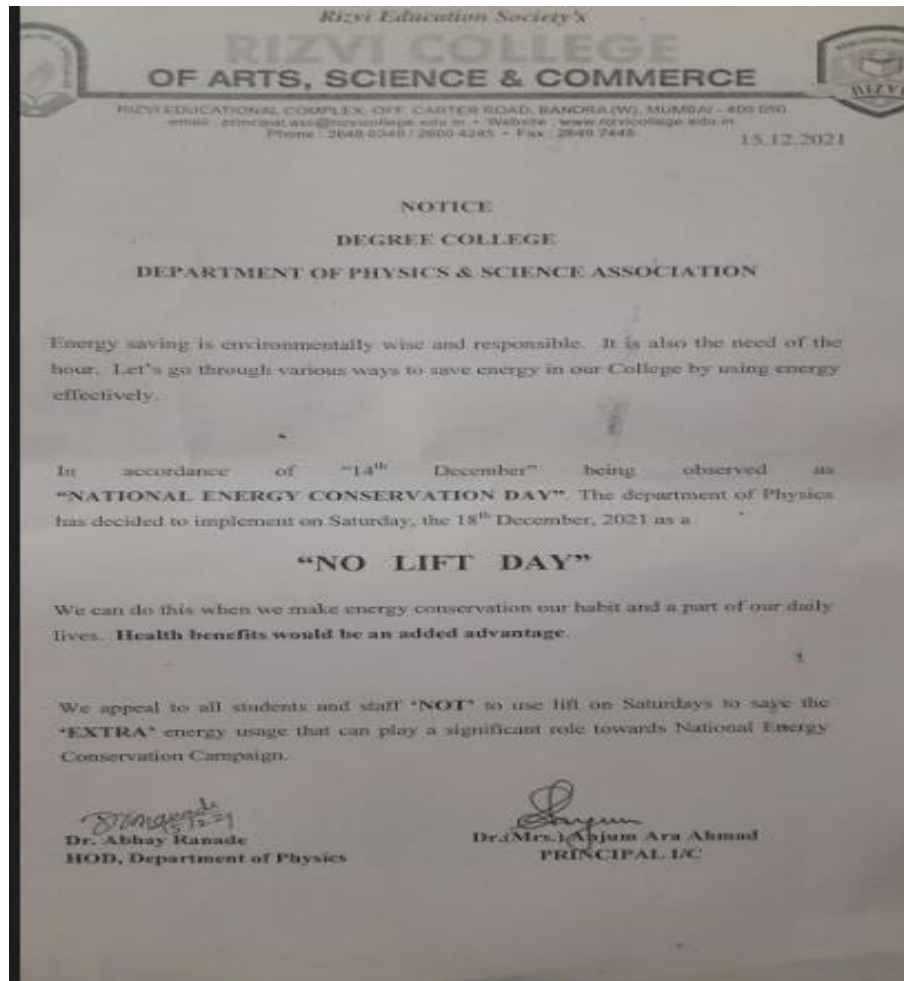
- A Webinar on Marine Pollution was conducted on 16th September 2021 by Zoology Department.

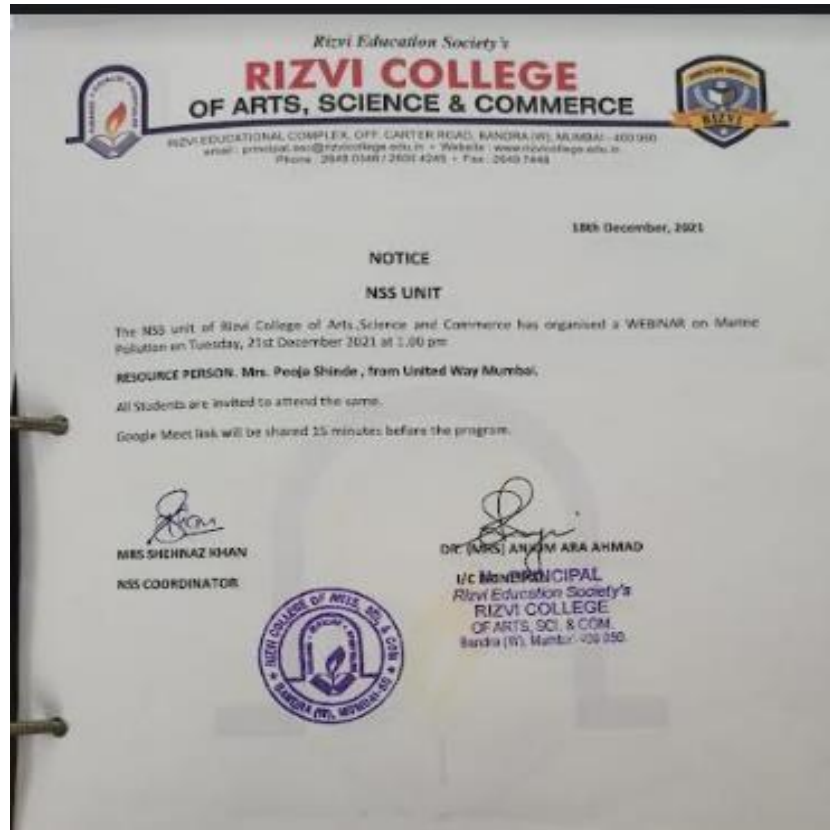

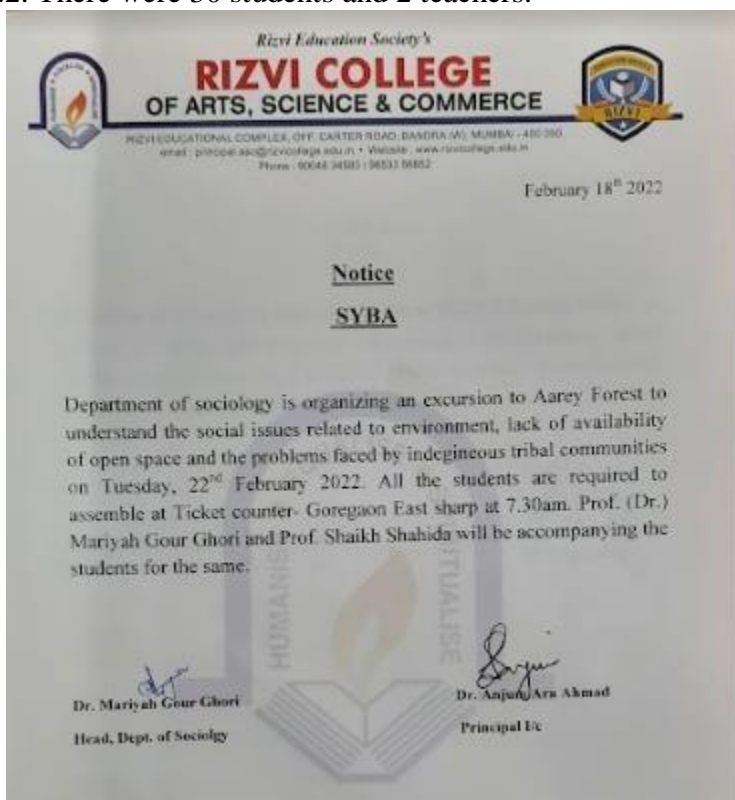

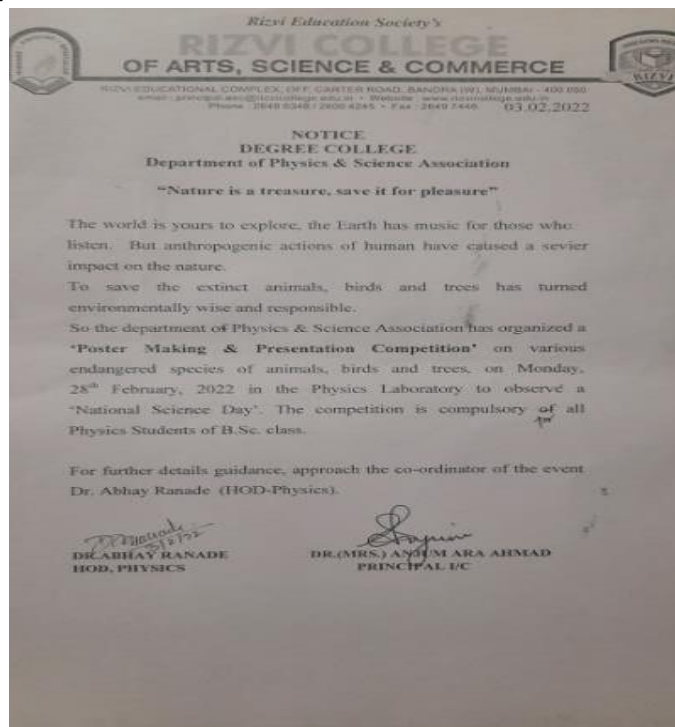
- A 'Beach Clean Up Drive' was organized by the Botany Department on 21st and 24th December, 2021 where 45 students participated in the event.



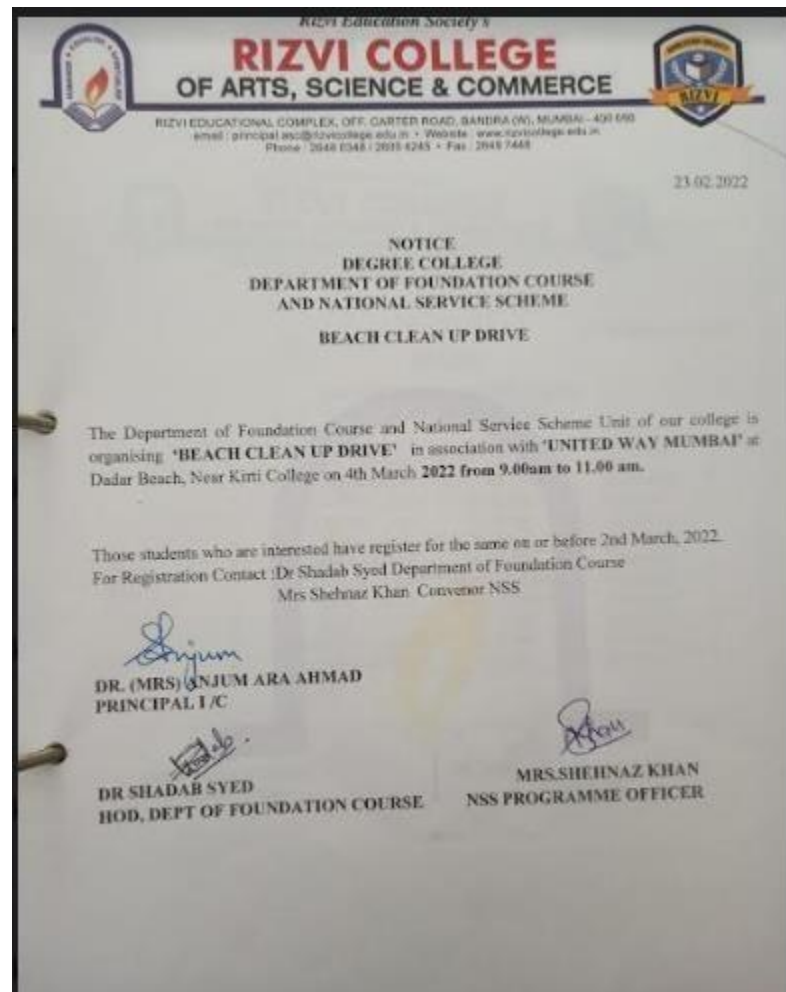
