







Session on Drug Abuse in Teenagers/Youth:






Blood donation and Mega Medical Camp:






• Voter Registration Drive (30/09/2017 to 10/10/2017) for BMC Elections:

It was College level Activity.


89 volunteers participated in the event which was held with Election Officials (Collector's Office, Bandra West). The event took place from 30/09/2017 to 10/10/2017.






• Awareness on HIV/AIDS Stigma:

This activity was a part of our Area Based Activity – I i.e. Health Awareness.


It was conducted by Health Department of Maharashtra on 28th January, 2018. Our 50 NSS Volunteers participated.
