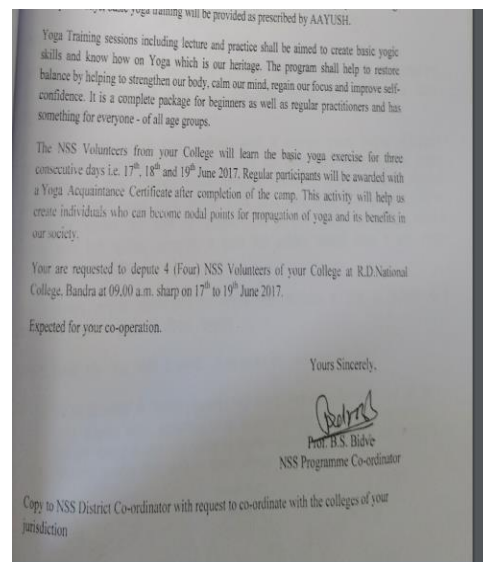
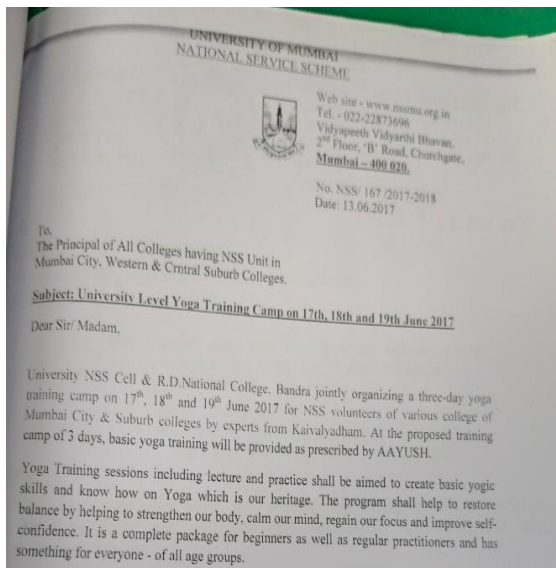

- **Yoga Training Session:**

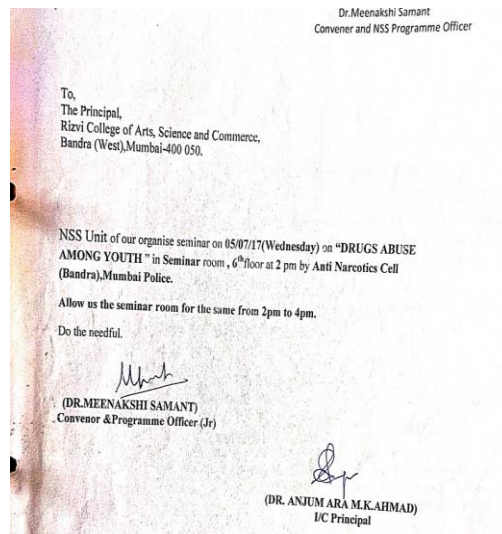
This activity was the part of our Area Based Activity – I i.e. Health Awareness.

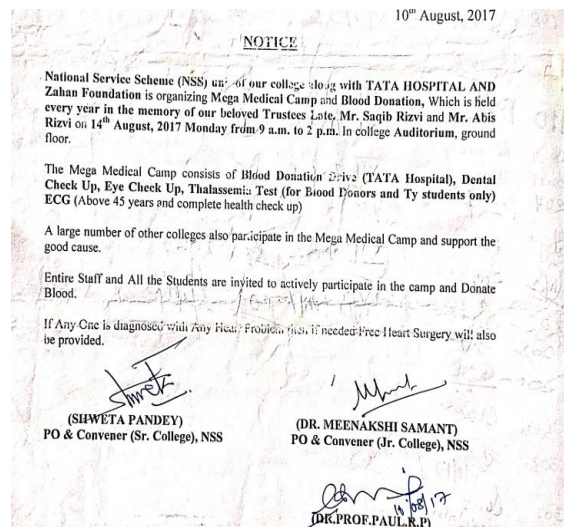
- **Session on Drug Abuse in Teenagers/Youth:**

This activity was a part of our Area Based Activity – I i.e. Health Awareness.

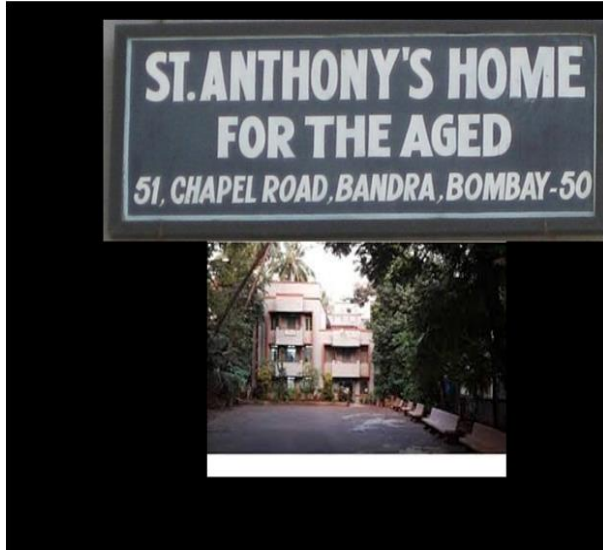
It was conducted by Health Department of Maharashtra on 28th January, 2018. Our 50 NSS Volunteers participated.
