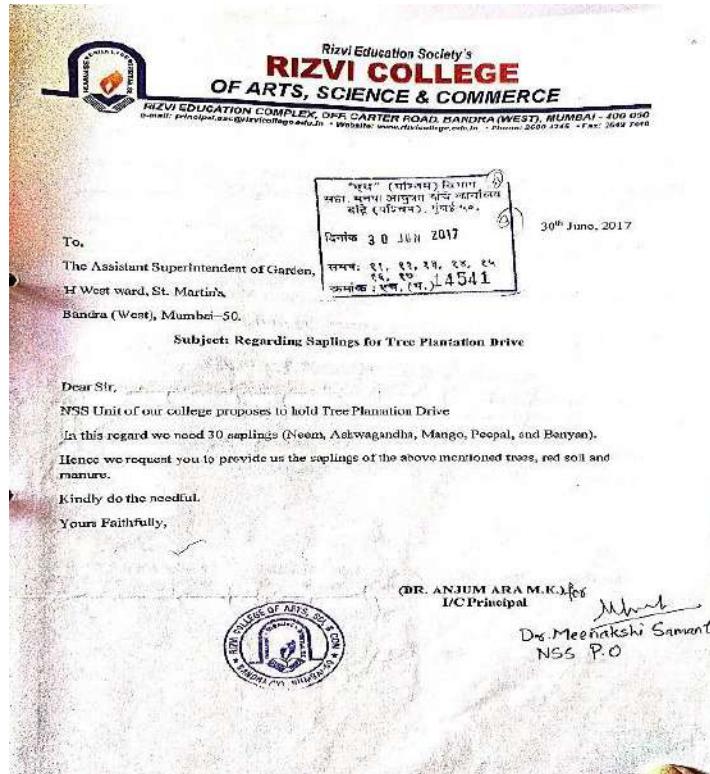

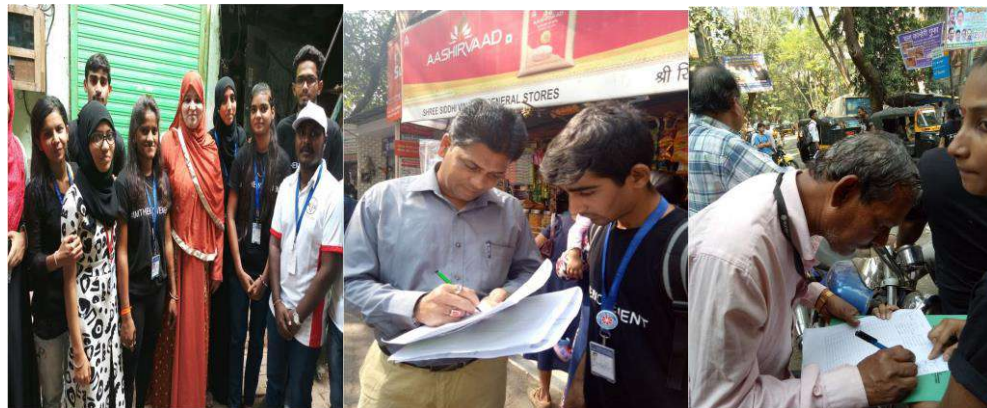
- **Tree plantation:**

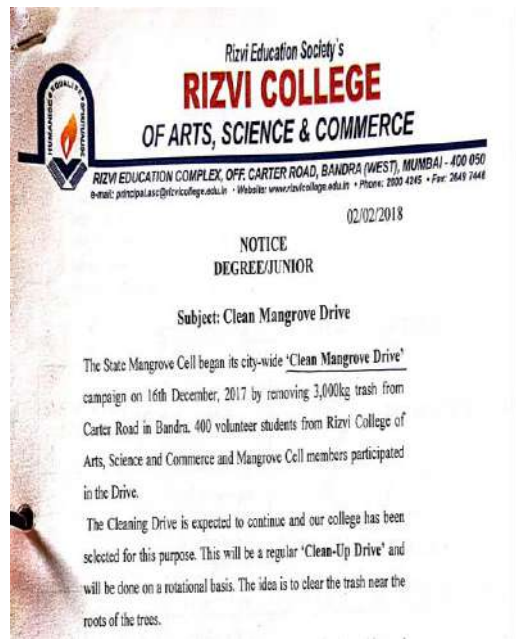


- Through the NSS following activities were conducted to promote social awareness

Session wise duty has been allotted to Departments and Faculties and they are required to conduct the activity along with the students of respective classes allotted to them.

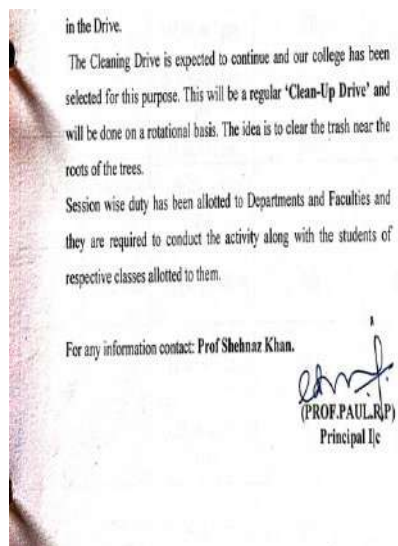
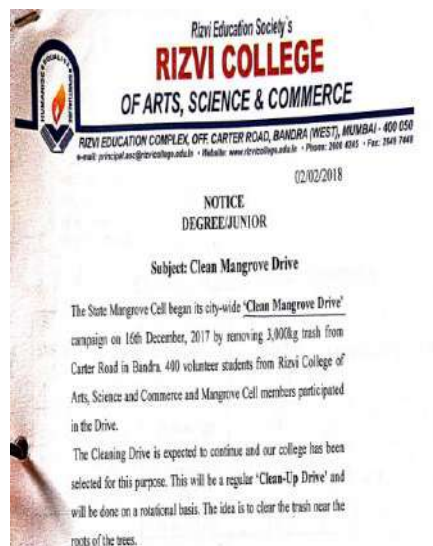

To observe the day, department of Physics has organised a "PPT ONLINE Competition" for F.Y.B.Sc. students on Monday, the 14th December, 2020.

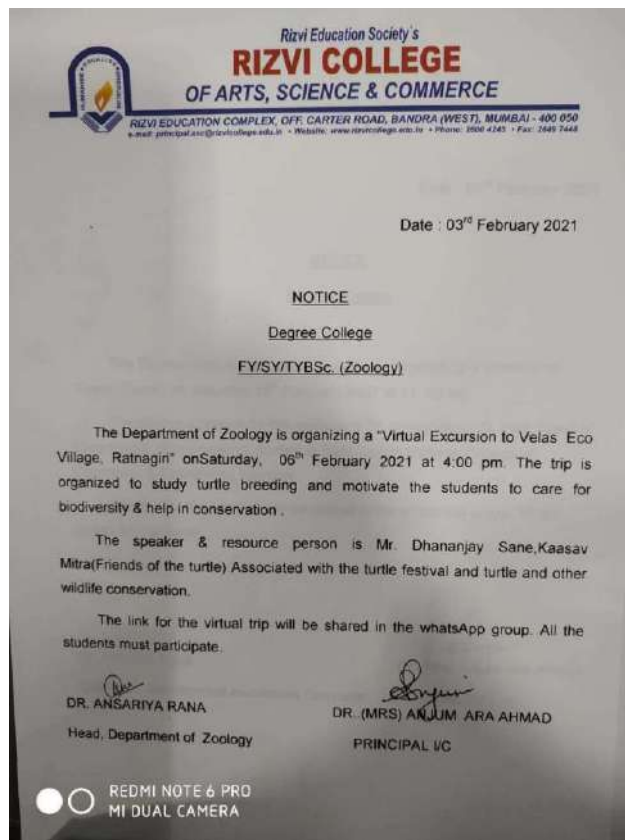

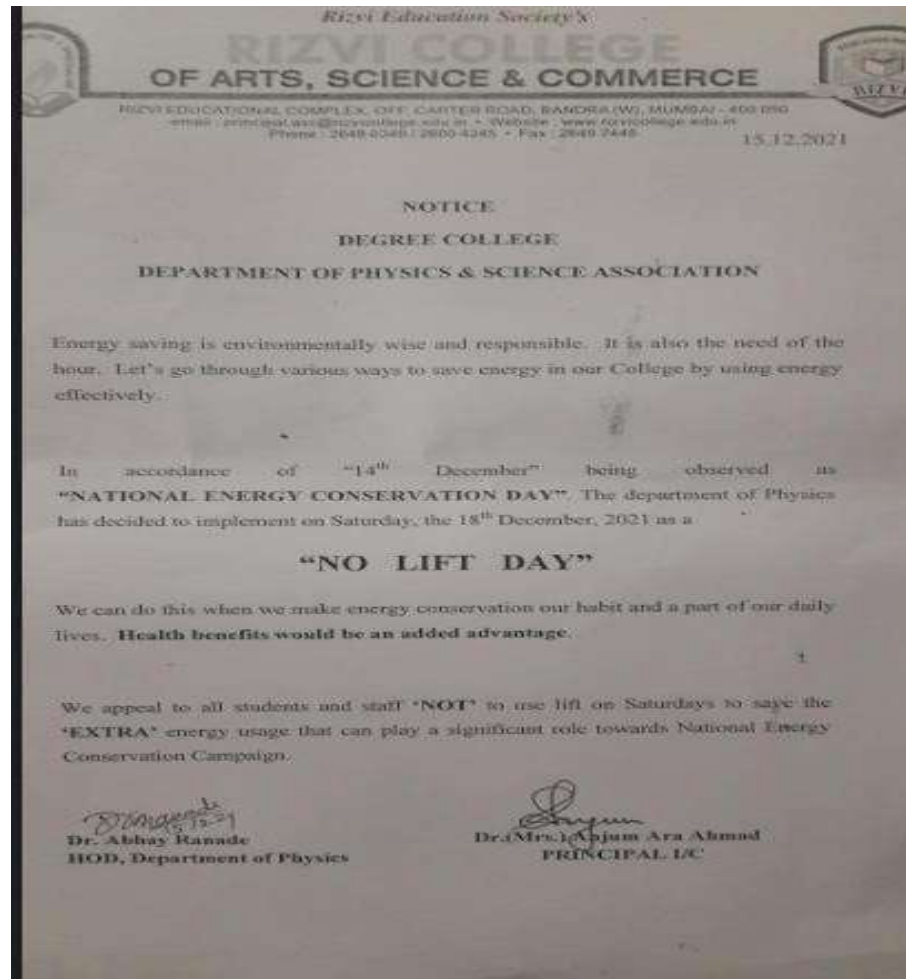
- A Webinar on Marine Pollution was conducted on 16th September 2021 by Zoology Department.

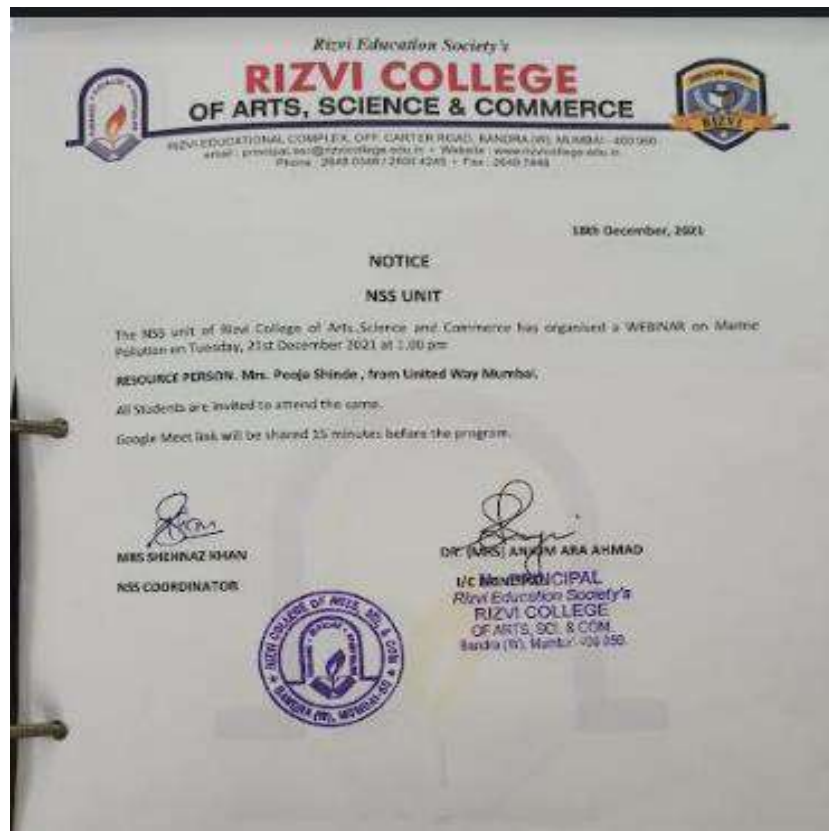

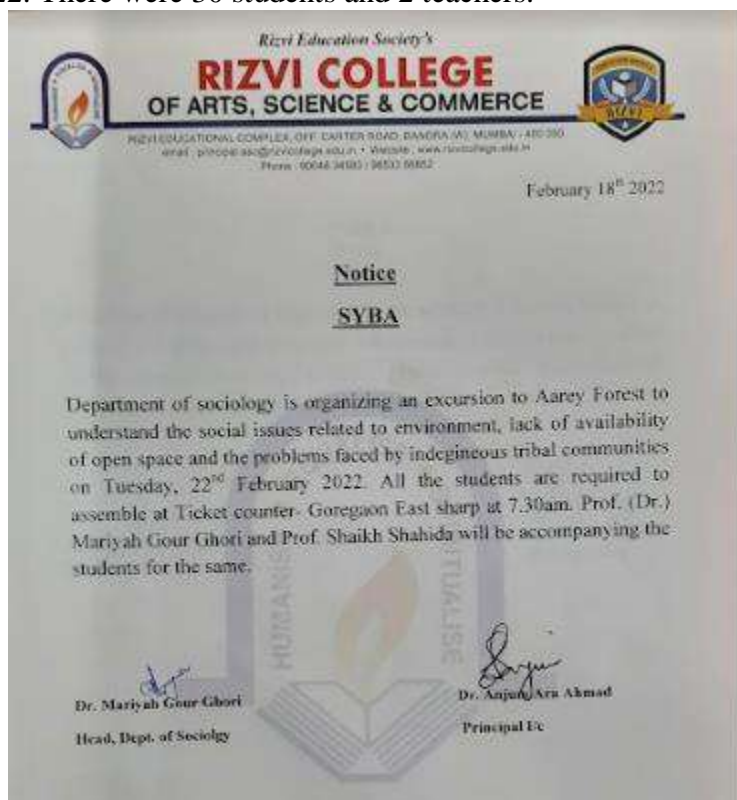

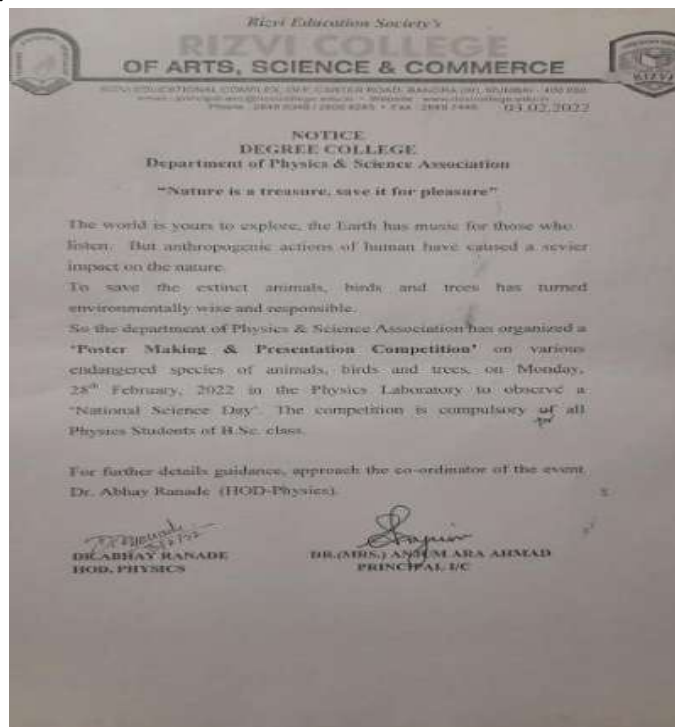
- A 'Beach Clean Up Drive' was organized by the Botany Department on 21st and 24th December, 2021 where 45 students participated in the event.



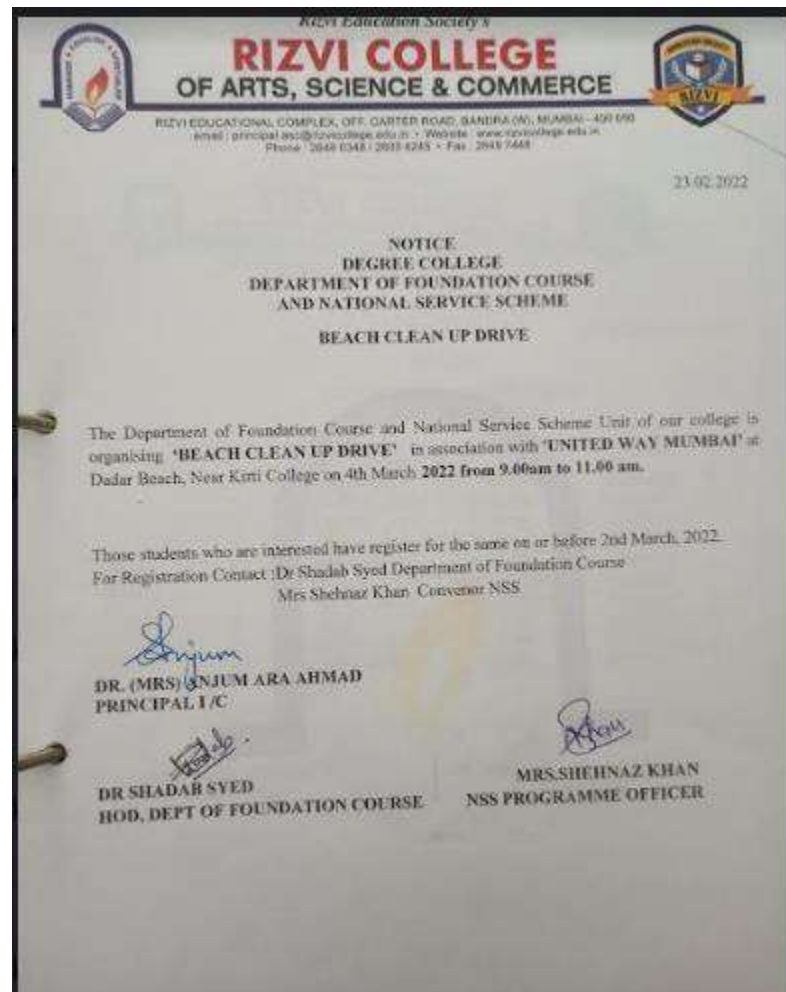
