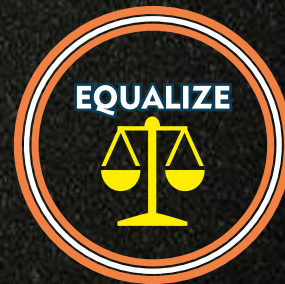

STUDENT MEGA EVENT DIGIFEST 2 (2021-22)

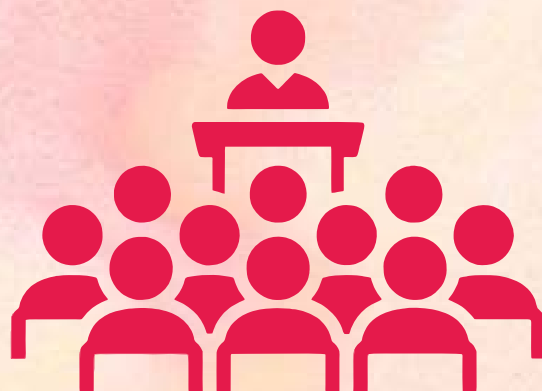

NATIONAL CADET CORPS

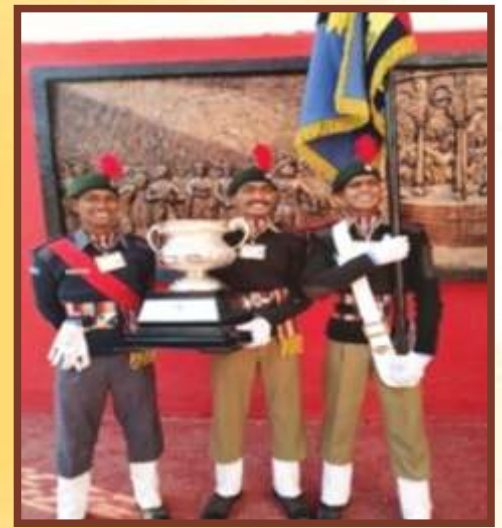

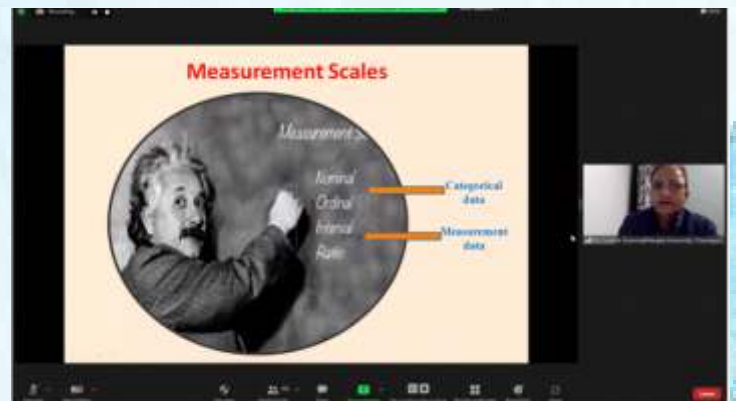
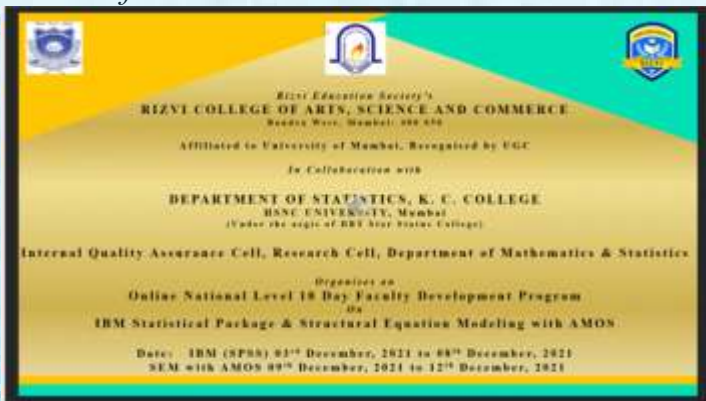
Valedictory address was delivered by Dr. Hemlata Bagla, Vice Chancellor, HSNC University, Mumbai and Principal, K C College, Mumbai

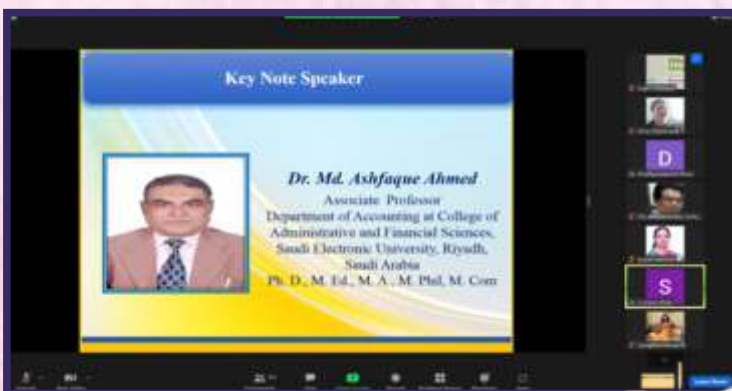
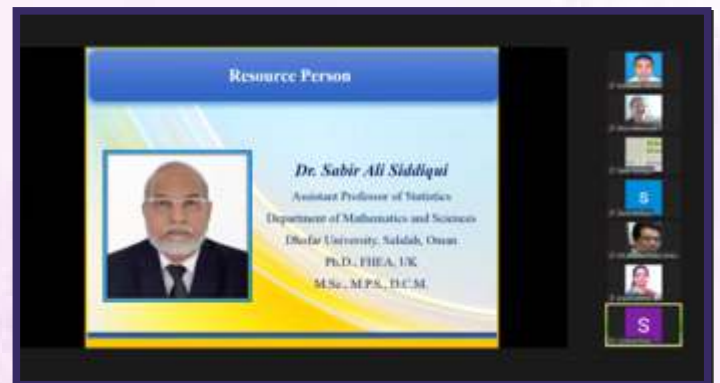

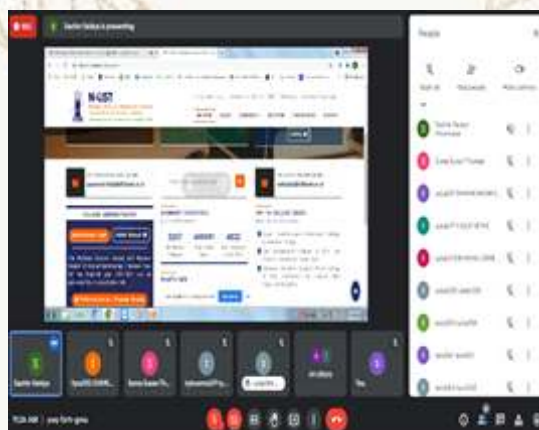


2) Online orientation program "Guide to accessing NLIST e-resources and other academic e-resources"

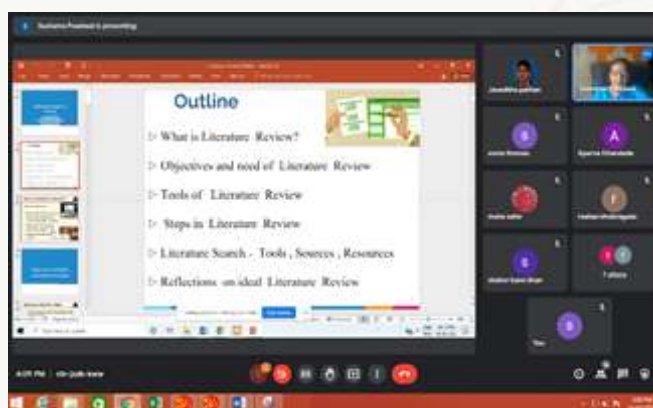
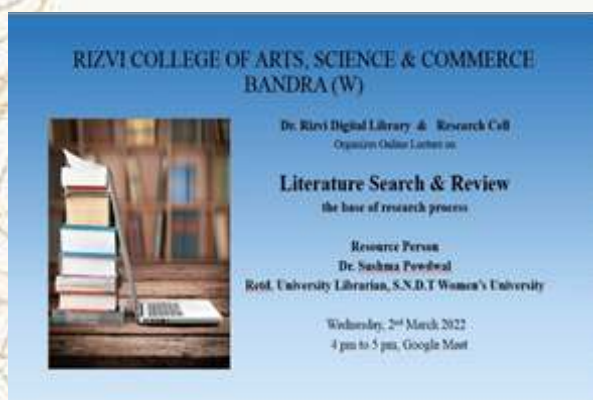
4) I Love my Library Initiative : Competition on Library Opinion Essays and Library Facts. 28th January, 2022

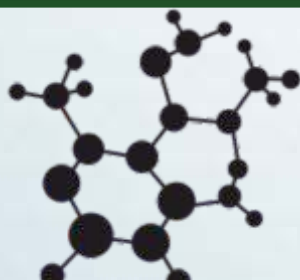
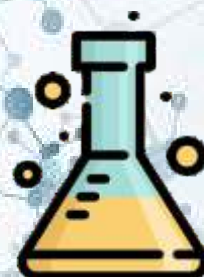


DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज कोण होते ?



जन्म: 19 फेब्रुवारी 1630

मृत्यू: 3 एप्रिल 1680

भारताच्या शूर सुपुत्रांपैकी एक असलेल्या श्रीमंत छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांबद्दल सर्वांनाच माहिती आहे. बरेच लोक त्यांना हिंदुहृदयसम्राट म्हणतात, तर काही लोक त्यांना मराठा अभिमान म्हणतात, तर ते भारतीय प्रजासत्ताकचे महान नायक होते. छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांचा जन्म 19 फेब्रुवारी 1630 रोजी मराठा कुटुंबात झाला. काही लोक त्याचा जन्म 1627 मध्ये सांगतात. त्यांचे पूर्ण नाव छत्रपती शिवाजी शहाजी भोंसले.

छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांचं युद्ध कौशल्य, त्यांची नीतिमत्ता, परस्त्री विषयीचा त्यांना असलेला आदर हे गुण आपल्याला माहिती आहेत. परंतु या सगळ्या गुणांच्या व्यतिरिक्त एक विशेष बाब महाराजांमध्ये होती, ती म्हणजे छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज पहिले क्रांतिकारक होते, ज्यांनी आपल्याला सांगितलं की हा देश आपला आहे, यावर सर्वप्रथम आपला अधिकार आहे, इथे आपलं राज्य असलं पाहिजे, स्वराज्य असलं पाहिजे. शिवरायांनी हे केवळ सांगितलं नही तर कृती केली. इस्लामी साम्राज्य हे परकीय साम्राज्य आहे. ते मोडून टाकून इथे हिंदवी स्वराज्य स्थापन झालं पाहिजे. हे हिंदवी स्वराज्य व्हावे ही श्रींची इच्छा हे त्यांचं ब्रीदवाक्य होतं... ही त्यांची श्रद्धा होती आणि पाहा, आज आपण स्वराज्य स्थापन केलं आहे... इथे आज आपलं राज्य आहे. या मातीतल्या लोकांचं राज्य आहे. ज्यूंचा स्वतःचा असा इस्रायल नावाचा देश आहे. तो देश त्यांनी पराक्रमाने निर्माण केला आहे. (जगामध्ये केवळ पाकीस्तान नावाचा देश आहे जो संघर्ष न करता निर्माण झाला आहे). छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांची जी निष्ठा होती तशीच निष्ठा ज्यू लोकांनी दाखवली... "नेक्स्ट इयर इन जेरुसलेम" हे त्यांचं ब्रीदवाक्य होतं... ही श्रद्धा होती त्यांची... ती श्रद्धा विश्वामध्ये छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांनी निर्माण केली आहे. महात्मा गांधी शिवरायांचं तत्व त्यागून ज्या राम राज्याची चर्चा करत होते, ते राम राज्य छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांनी स्थापन केलं आहे.

سیاست کوئی کھیل نہیں بلکہ ایک سنجیدہ کاروبار ہے۔ یہ قول ہے انگلینڈ کے سابق وزیر اعظم ونسٹن چرچل کا۔ یہ قول موجودہ سیاست کی بالکل صحیح نشاندہی کرتا ہے۔ سیاست ایک راہ کے مانند ہے اور سماج اس مسافر کی مانند ہے جو اس راہ پر گامزن ہو۔ یعنی جو طرز سیاست ہم اختیار کریں گے اس اعتبار سے ہمیں مستقبل میں حالات کا سامنا ہوگا اور ان حالات کا اثر صرف کسی منفرد گروہ پر نہیں ہوگا بلکہ ایک پورے ملک یا پوری قوم اثر انداز ہوگی، خواہ وہ نتائج مثبت ہو یا منفی۔

سیاست زمانہ قدیم سے ہی انسانی معاشرے میں پائی جاتی ہے۔ تاریخ کی ورق گردانی سے معلوم ہوتا ہے کہ حکومتوں کا عروج و زوال بھی کامرہون منت رہا ہے۔ ہمارے ملک میں بھی حکمرانوں اور سلطنتوں کے ساتھ ساتھ سیاست کے طرز بھی تبدیل ہوتے گئے اور سماج سیاست سے ہمیشہ اثر انداز ہوتا رہا۔ کبھی سیاست کی وجہ سے ہم غلام بن گئے اور کبھی سیاست کے سبب ہی ہمیں آزادی نصیب ہوئی۔ دوسری جنگ عظیم کے اختتام کے کچھ عرصے بعد ہی ہمارا ملک آزاد ہو گیا۔ یہ وہ دور تھا جب سیاست کی نوعیت تیزی سے تبدیل ہو رہی تھی جس کا اثر معاشرے پر بھی ہو رہا تھا۔

دور حاضر میں جو سیاست ہو رہی ہے وہ محض ذاتی مفاد کی بنا پر ہو رہی ہے۔ بچپن میں ہمیں جو سیاسیات بطور مضمون اسکولوں میں پڑھایا گیا اور جو درحقیقت سیاست ہو رہی ہے ان دونوں میں زمین و آسمان کا فرق ہے۔ ہمارے ملک ہندوستان میں سیاست ایک ایسے اسلحے کے طور پر استعمال ہوتی ہے جس سے سماج میں نفرت اور تعصب پیدا کر کے لوگوں کو آپس میں دست و گریباں کر کے ووٹ حاصل کیے جاتے ہیں۔ لوگوں کو ذات و مذہب کے نام پر لڑوانا سیاستدانوں کے لیے ووٹ کے ساتھ ساتھ اس لیے بھی ضروری ہے کہ لوگوں کا ذہن اصل مدعوں جیسے تعلیم، روزگار، صحت وغیرہ سے ہٹایا جائے اور ان سیاستدانوں سے کبھی ضروری مدعوں پر سوال اٹھانے والا کوئی باقی نہ رہے اور اگر کوئی سوال کرے تو اسے کسی طرح خاموش کر دیں۔

ہندوستان آج مذہبی سیاست اور اس سے ہونے والے مضرت اثرات کی سب سے بڑی مثال ہے۔ اس منقسم کرنے والی سیاست نے پچھلی کچھ دہائیوں میں ملک میں کئی فسادات پیدا کیے۔ افسوس کی بات یہ ہے کہ سیاسی جماعتوں کے ارکان بھی ان فسادات میں ملوث پائے جاتے ہیں۔ لوگوں کو آپس میں تقسیم کر کے سیاسی جماعتوں کو فائدے تو حاصل ہو جاتے ہیں لیکن معاشرے پر ایسے منفی اثرات مرتب ہوتے ہیں جن کا ازلہ ممکن نہیں ہوتا مثلاً، ممبئی اور گجرات کے مذہبی فسادات میں جان و مال کا بہت بڑا نقصان ہوا۔ اگر ہم غور کریں تو ہمیں معلوم ہوگا کہ ان سبھی فسادات میں سیاست کا بہت بڑا کردار تھا اور اس کاروباری سیاست کے سبب ہمارے ملک کی فضا میں ایسی نفرت پھیلی کہ اب بھی اس نفرت کے اثرات لوگوں کے خیالات سے ظاہر ہوتے ہیں۔ جس ملک میں مختلف مذاہب سے تعلق رکھنے والے لوگ عرصہ طویل سے امن اور محبت کے ساتھ زندگی بسر کرتے تھے اسی ملک میں آج تعصب کی فضا پھیلی ہوئی ہے۔ جو سیاستدان اور سیاسی جماعتیں مذہبی ہونے کا نالک کرتی ہیں ان کا مذہب سے دور دور تک کوئی واسطہ نہیں ہوتا پر چونکہ یہ لوگ جان چکے ہیں کہ ہندوستانی شہری مذہبی معاملات میں کافی حساس طبیعت رکھتے ہیں تو انھوں نے اس کا غلط استعمال شروع کر دیا۔ نادان عوام نے اسے غیرت کا مسئلہ جان کر اس سیاست میں حصہ لیا اور اصل مسائل اور مدعوں سے بہک کر آپس میں لڑ پڑے۔

سیاست نے معاشرے میں ذات، زبان اور خطے کے نام پر بھی لوگوں کو بانٹا اور بیوقوف بنایا۔ ملک کے دیہی علاقوں میں آج بھی لوگ ایک مخصوص ذات کو ادنیٰ اور کم تر سمجھتے ہیں۔ اگر ہماری حکومت یا پھر سیاسی جماعتیں چاہیں تو اس تفریق کو ختم کر سکتی ہیں کچھ سماج میں میں بیداری پیدا کر کے اور کچھ قوانین کو سخت کر کے اس مسئلے کا حل نکل سکتا ہے۔ لیکن ہماری سیاسی جماعتیں اس کے برعکس کرتی نظر آتی ہیں۔ اور خود ہی نسل پرستی کو فروغ دیتی ہیں تاکہ اس کے ذریعے ان کا کچھ مفاد نکل آئے۔ اس طرز عمل سے جو سیاسی جماعتیں اپنا رہی ہیں محض سماج میں مختلف طبقات اور گروہوں کے درمیان نا اتفاقی اور دوریاں بڑھتی جا رہی ہیں۔

سیاست اور سماج

ہمارے ملک کی پہچان ہمارے ملک میں پائی جانے والی انواع و اقسام کی تہذیبیں ہیں اور زبانیں بھی ہیں۔ مگر سیاست نے اس خوبصورتی کو بھی نشانہ بنایا ہے۔ اس قسم کی خبریں بھی ہم سنتے اور دیکھتے رہتے ہیں کہ فلاں ریاست کی سیاسی جماعت نے کسی ریاست کے باشندوں کے داخلے پر پابندی کی مانگ کر دی ہے تو کسی سیاست کے باشندوں کے داخلے پر پابندی کی مانگ کر دی ہے تو کسی جگہ کسی غیر مقامی شخص کو ہراساں کیا گیا تو کسی جگہ زبان کی بنیاد پر کسی کو نوکری سے نکال دیا گیا وغیرہ۔ یہ ساری خبریں ہمیں بتاتی ہیں کہ معاشرہ کس قدر تقسیم ہو گیا ہے۔ ہمارا طرز سیاست ہمیں ہی دھیرے دھیرے توڑتا جا رہا ہے۔

ایک جماعت کا دوسری سیاسی جماعت پر الزام لگانا بھی ہماری سیاسی جماعتوں کا عظیم مشغلہ ہے۔ سیاست کے نام پر جتنی نا انصافیاں اور غیر ضروری تنازعات موجود ہیں وہ انہیں سیاسی جماعتوں کی آپسی رنجشوں کا نتیجہ ہے۔ کسی سیاسی جماعت نے اپنے دور اقتدار میں فلاح کے کام کیے ہوں یا نہ کیے ہوں لیکن اس کا دوسری جماعت کو نشانہ بنانا لازمی ہے اور اسی طرح زیر اقتدار جماعت اپنی ناکامیوں کا ٹھیکر اگزشتہ حکومتوں پر پھوڑ کر اپنا پلہ جھاڑ لیتی ہے اور عوام تذبذب کا شکار ہو جاتی ہے کہ آخر ذمہ دار کسے ٹھہرائے؟ بعض اوقات یہ سیاسی جماعتیں ایک دوسرے سے پر ذاتی الزامات لگانے سے بھی گریز نہیں کرتیں اور بد اخلاقی اور بد تمیزی کی ساری حدیں پار کر دیتی ہیں۔ جب ملک کے اعلیٰ عہدیدار اور ذمہ دار افراد ایسی نازیبا حرکات انجام دیں گے تو عام شہری سے سلیقہ مندی کی امید لگانا صرف حماقت ہے۔ ہمارے یہاں سیاست کے نام پر لوگوں کے یقین کا بھی گلا گھونٹ دیا جاتا ہے۔ الیکشن میں بد عنوانیاں اور بے ایمانیاں عام ہو گئی ہیں۔ کبھی کوئی سیاسی جماعت دوسری جماعت کے امیدواروں کو خرید کر اپنی سرکار بنا کر موجودہ حکومت کو درہم برہم کر دیتی ہے تو کبھی اسے بغاوت کا نام دے کر عوام کو تسلی دی جاتی ہے۔ ان سبھی واقعات سے عوام کا بھروسہ جمہوریت پر سے اٹھ جاتا ہے اور معاشرے میں بھی بد عنوانیوں کا رجحان بڑھ جاتا ہے۔

سیاستدان اس دور میں انہیں کاموں اور ذمہ داریوں سے بے خبر رہتے ہیں جن کے لیے عوام نے انہیں منتخب کیا اور ان پر اعتبار کیا لیکن، آپ کو ہمارے سیاستدانوں میں ذاتی مفاد اور طاقت کے حصول کے لیے لوگوں میں ذات و مذہب کی بنیاد پر تفریق کرنے کا رجحان بڑے پیمانے پر نظر آئے گا۔ جنہیں سماج یا معاشرے میں اصلاح کے لیے کوشش کرنی چاہیے تھی وہی لوگ معاشرے میں زہر گھولنے کا کام انجام دے رہے ہیں۔

جناب چرچل کے جس قول کا تذکرہ کیا گیا وہ ہمارے ملک کی سیاسی حالات کی ہو ہو عکاسی کرتا ہے۔ جہاں سیاست نے ایک کاروبار کی حیثیت حاصل اختیار کر لی ہے وہی ملک اور قوم کی ترقی بالائے طاق رکھی ہوئی ہے۔ اکثر لوگ کہتے ہیں کہ سیاست میں داخل ہونا کسی گندی نالی میں داخل ہونے کے مترادف ہے لیکن کمال تو تب ہوگا جب کوئی اس گندی نالی میں گندا ہونے نہیں بلکہ اس نالی کو صاف کرنے کے مقصد سے داخل ہو۔

ملک کی سیاست میں عوام کا کردار بڑا اہم ہوتا ہے اس لیے ہمیں بھی اس بات کا احساس ہونا چاہیے کہ قوم کی بھلائی کے لیے اور مسائل کے حل کے لیے اس قسم کی سیاست سے گریز کرنا چاہیے جو امن اور سلامتی کے لیے خطرہ ہوں اور اس قسم کی سیاست کو بڑھاوانہ دیں جو انتشار پیدا کرتی ہوں۔ ہمیں اصلیت سے واقف رہنا چاہیے اور محتاط رہنا چاہیے کہ کہیں ہم کسی کے ہاتھوں کا کھلونا تو نہیں بن رہے؟ یہ ہم پر منحصر ہے کہ ہم کس طرح کی سیاست کو فروغ دیں اور اسی اعتبار سے اپنے مستقبل کا انتخاب کریں۔

बिटिया कहते ही सना इब्राहिम की ओर दौड़ पड़ती। अपने वालिद के छोटे-छोटे काम करती। भाईयों की कामों में मदद करती। घर-भर सब उसपर जान छिड़कते थे। सना अब स्कूल जाने लगी थी। सना को दिनी पढ़ाई के साथ, दुनियाई इल्म भी हासिल हो। इसलिए उसके भाईयों की तरह उसका भी एडमिशन पास के स्कूल में करवा दिया गया था। वह रोज सवेरे उठती, अरबी मदरसा जाती। वहाँ से लौटकर थोड़ी देर खेलती और बाद में तैयार होकर स्कूल चली जाती। स्कूल से लौटने पर ट्यूशन जाती और बाद में होमवर्क करके सो जाती।

अब सना का सारा समय अपने कामों की व्यस्तता में गुजरता। थोड़ा समय बैठकर वह अपने माता-पिता से गपशप लड़ाती। माता-पिता सना को अपने आँखों का सुकून मानते थे। मरयम ने सना के लिए अपने हाथों से उलन का बेहतरीन स्वेटर बुना था। जो उसपर बहुत ही खुलता था। इब्राहिम ने भी रंग-बिरंगी कुर्ता-शलवार के चार-पांच जोड़े खरीद लाये थे। चारों भाईयों की सना बेहत लाडली थी। चारों भाईयों को घर से जो भी पैसे मिलते उसे वह जमा करते थे और सना के लिए चूड़ियाँ, गले का हार, साज-शृंगार की चीजें आदि ले आते थे।

सना के स्कूल में एक नया चपरासी आया था जिसका नाम अल्ताफ़ था। यही कोई पैंतीस-चालीस वर्ष का रहा होगा। बच्चे स्कूल के चपरासी को यदि वह आदमी हो तो चाचा और औरत को खाला या भाभी बुलाते थे। नया चपरासी अल्ताफ़ काम में बहुत ही तत्पर था। जिससे उसने स्कूल के कुछ टीचर्स के दिल जित लिए थे। कुछ टीचर्स उसे चाटुकारिता का चतुर बीरबल मानते थे। जो उसे ना पसंद करते अपने पास फटकने भी नहीं देते। और जो टीचर्स उसे पसंद करते थे उनके आगे-पीछे वह भौरे की तरह मंडराता था।

स्कूल के बच्चे उसे चाचा – चाचा कहते। एक दिन शबाना टीचर ने सना को अल्ताफ़ चाचा से रजिस्टर लाने के लिए कहा। सना अल्ताफ़ चाचा से वह चीजें तो ले आई मगर उसकी मीठी बातों में फंस गई। आए दिन अल्ताफ़ सना से बातें करता। सना का साफ़ दिल था वह अल्ताफ़ चचा से बातें करती। स्कूल में जाते ही अल्ताफ़ चचा से सलाम-दुआं होती। मध्याह्नभोजन के अवकाश समय मिला तो अल्ताफ़ किसी न किसी बहाने सना से बतियाने आ जाया करता।

सना के चार भाई थे जो उससे बड़े थे। बड़ा भाई लतीफ़ बहुत ही नर्म दिल था। कम उम्र में पारिवारिक जिम्मेदारियाँ कब उसके कंधों पर आकर पड़ी उसे समझ में ही नहीं आया। दुसरा भाई वसीम पढ़ाई के मामले में दिलचस्पी नहीं दिखाता था। अबू और बड़े भाई के काम में सहायता करना, घर के काम करना इसीमें इसका सारा समय निकल जाता था। अन्य दो भाई दसवीं और बारहवी कक्षाओं में थे। घर में पढ़ाई करने वाले अकरम, शाफ़े और सना ही थे। स्कूल से आते खाना खाते और थोड़ा समय कुछ इधर-उधर खेलकूद लेने के बाद तीनों बच्चे पढ़ाई के लिए बैठ जाते। सना भाईयों के मुकाबले पढ़ाई में बहुत तेज थी। दोनों भाईयों का होमवर्क अधूरा रहता पर सना हमेशा अपना पूरा होमवर्क करती थी। कभी-कभी सना की पढ़ने की आदत से तंग आकर मरयम उससे कहती "सना अब बस भी कर... पढ़ाई, कितना भी पढ़ो औरत को आखिरकार चुल्हा-चक्की ही संभालनी पड़ती है।" सना जवाब में कहती "अम्मी बस हुई तुम्हारी यह घिसी-पिटी बातें... कभी पढ़ाई को अच्छा भी कहा करो, क्या आपको नहीं पता औरतों के लिए पढ़ाई करना आज के समय में कितना जरूरी है।", "अम्मी आप भी बस एक जैसी रट लगाती हो "पढ़ाई बस भी करो सना कहकर; मैं मेरी पढ़ाई किये बिना नहीं उठ सकती। अम्मी उस्ताद ने कहा कि पढ़ाई भी एक तरह की इबादत होती है।"
