Our students Prathmesh Mishra (TYBSc – Physics 2018-19) secured AIR – 148 (80.73 percentile) in JEST examination.


2)International Day for the "Prevention of the Ozone layer" was observed (16 September):

5) Constitution day or National Law Day (26th November) :




