## Screening of Documentary “Western Hills” by Prof. Pankti Surve 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021

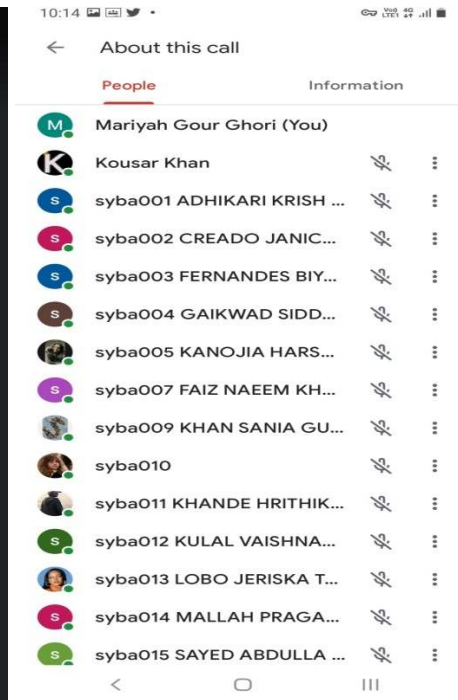
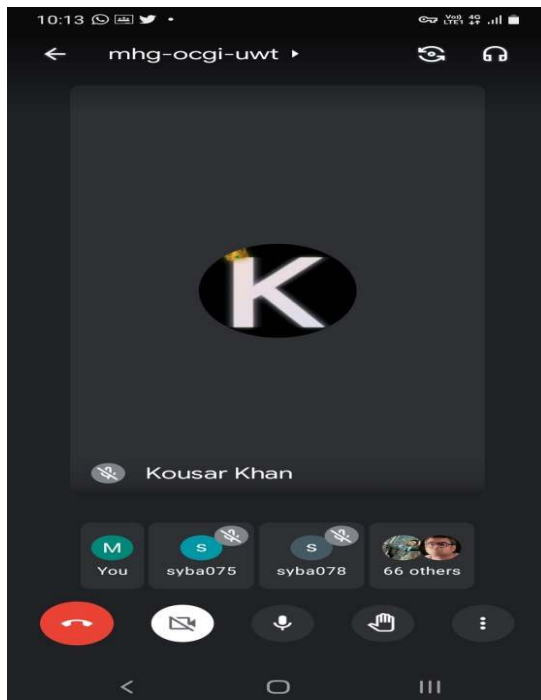
A documentary on Western Hills was Screened for the students of Arts Faculty on 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021 to sensitize them with the environmental and ecological issues associated with the region and the issues faced by the civilians residing in the adjourn areas. The screening was followed by discussion by Prof. Pankti Survey from University of Mumbai. The idea was to ensure sensitivity towards sustainable development in these areas by focussing on conservation of the ecosystem where so far no cognisance has been taken on the matter. The session was attended by 15 M/43 F. The screening led to a serious discussion amongst the students who were able to co-relate the numerous environmental hazards emerging out of it.



## Guest Lecture on “Women Entrepreneur” by Mrs. Kausar Khan

The guest lecture on Women Entrepreneur was held on Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2021. The resource person for the session was Mrs. Kausar Khan a single mother with 3 children. In order to sustain herself she providing tiffin services to over 150 informal workers in her residing slums. She narrated her life story and then explained how she has attained the economic independence with her tiffin services. The students were able to comprehend various minute details of her self-sufficiency and the process involved in it from buying of grocery to delivery of tiffins to the workers, managing the budget etc.

Prevailing online services has provided many youngsters especially women various avenues for online selling of goods to support their family. The experience of Kausar Khan led to a wide discussion in subsequent lectures as how one can take up startups with small investment and can become independent. Students came up with the ideas as how various artifacts can be brought from whole sale markets at competent rates and what can be the source of advertisements through online mode. The session was attended by 66 students comprising of 28 male students and 48 female students along with 2 faculty.

## Careers in Social Work by Taha Ratlamwala

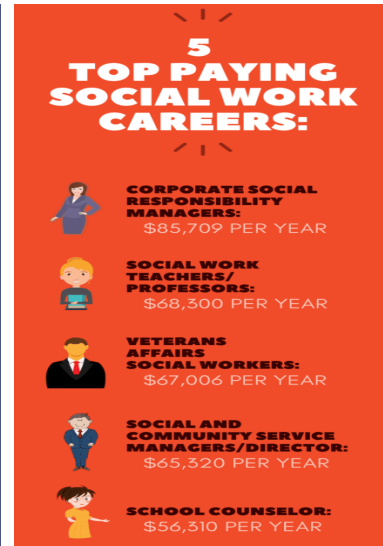
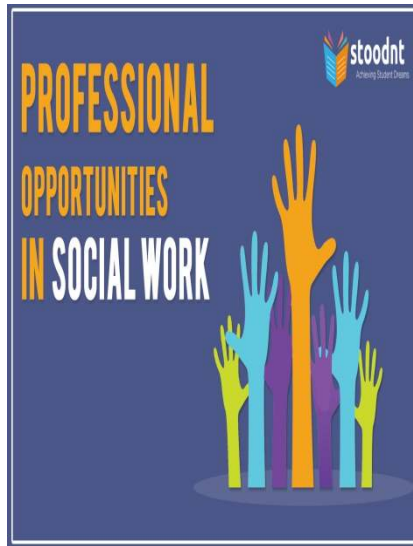
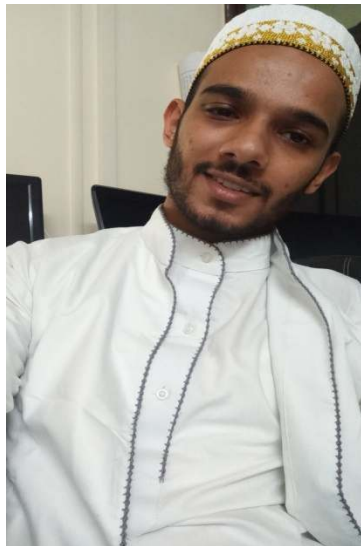

Holding a diploma in social science and social work he has been working with AKSHARA-Women Resource Center as Peer Guide since 2017. He works intensively with under privileged children from various backgrounds.

Resolves labor disputes between employers and employees. They help negotiate contracts and resolve conflicts between workers and management.

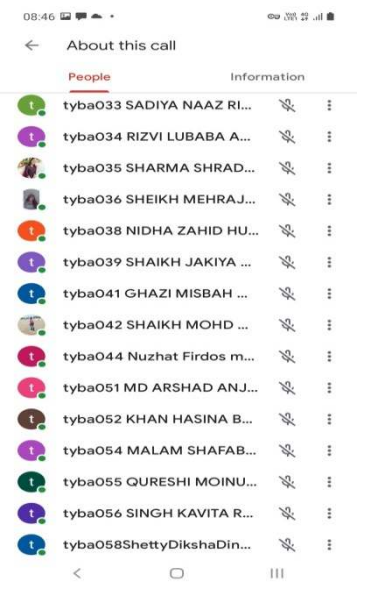
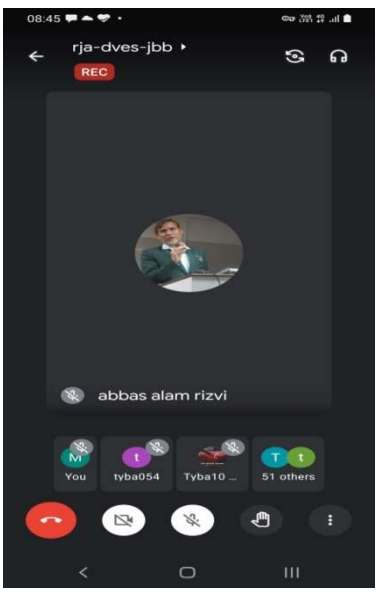
